Message From Paul Kalungi Jr: I've been a member of the parish since I was born, serving as an altar server and in the choir. Since joining the metropolitan cathedral choir over 10 years ago, I have been a part of many ensembles. I have had a part in the creation of 'The Hope Street Consort' and quite honestly it is my pride and joy to be part of such a wonderful group of singers. I would love to share this with the parish that I grew up in and that nurtured me both through music and through faith.

The Hope Street Consort are a Liverpool-based vocal ensemble who perform unaccompanied music from early polyphony to present day arrangements. Our singers are all current students or alumni of the University of Liverpool, and our name pays homage to Hope Street, a significant road that links the city's two cathedrals, where we frequently perform as lay clerks and choral scholars.

There aren't many opportunities like this for young singers in Liverpool, so we had to create our own. Thus, we started the consort and haven't looked back.
