BUILDING WORK

We are delighted to confirm that the redevelopment of our first floor (Currently Year 4) will begin next week. The works will be undertaken in 2 stages, the first will focus on the half of the floor closest to reception and the second on the half of the floor closest to Olivia's performance area.

Pupils in 4MW have already moved into the old Music room while works take place.

Once the first stage is complete all four classes will move into the four newly developed classes while the second stage of the works are completed.

Pupils will not be affected by the works, although you will see containers in front of the building where the contactors will be housed during the project. We have already practiced a Fire Evacuation with year 4 pupils and it was a complete success.

The build will not affect where you collect your child from after school.
