We can still defeat assisted suicide!

There is a clear path toward the assisted suicide Bill being defeated at Third Reading. Early analysis shows that at least 36 MPs supported the Bill but have concerns that mean they may vote NO at later stages. Just 28 MPs switching their stance to NO would ensure it is defeated at Third Reading. We need MPs to know that their constituents want them to vote NO at Third Reading.

Please take action now and visit <u>www.righttolife.org.uk/ASvote</u> to find out how your MP voted and ask them to vote against the Bill at Third Reading.

With the vote passing by a margin of only 55, just 28 MPs switching their stance to oppose the Bill would ensure it is defeated at Third Reading. Early analysis <u>already shows</u> at least 36 MPs who have indicated they have concerns which, if not addressed, will mean they rescind their support for the Bill.

There is no doubt that your support encouraging parishioners to send postcards, write to their MPs and attend MP meetings played a huge role in ensuring this small margin. Thank you!
