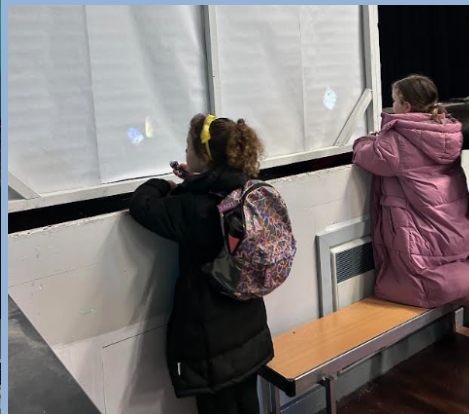

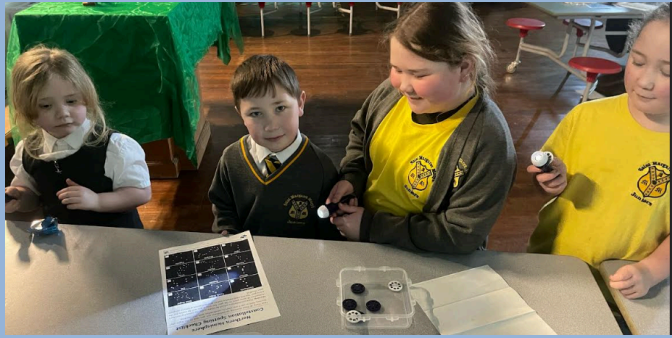

Thank you to all parents who attended this week's Physics Family Learning session. We hope you had fun with your child.



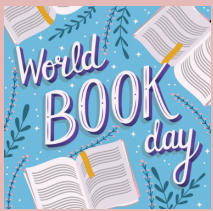


St David's Day
